ADRIAN- Norman "Norm" Bernard Lichtenberg, 90, of Adrian, MI died on Monday afternoon, December 11, 2023 at home with his loving wife by his side and under the care of Hospice of Lenawee

Norm was born on March 17, 1933 in Detroit, MI the oldest son of Bernhard and Charlotte (Krix) Lichtenberg. He grew up in Detroit and went on to earn a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering at Wayne State University in 1956. After completing his education, Norm served his country in the United States Air Force from 1956 to 1959.

While Norm was attending WSU he met his future wife, Janet Bertam. After Norm and Janet graduated from college, they were united in marriage on August 26, 1956 at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Detroit. They were blessed with four children and shared many wonderful memories during their 67 years together.

Norm had a mind that was constantly working, figuring out problems and paying close attention to details; this was a plus in his career as a mechanical engineer. He primarily worked with automotive suppliers and was employed with Vickers in Troy, MI for 15 years. Norm had several patents from his designs for unique automotive devices. In his free time, he enjoyed reading, playing the violin with Janet and boating out on the lake. The family had many camping adventures from their time on Black Lake and at Port Crescent State Park. Norm was an active member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Adrian since 1960.

In addition to his wife, Janet, Norm is survived by their children, Karen Wood, Dale (Rebecca) Lichtenberg, Ralph (Darla) Lichtenberg and daughter-in-law, Debbie Lichtenberg; 12 grandchildren and many wonderful great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; brother, Harold Lichtenberg; and son, Glen Lichtenberg.
