ADRIAN – Olga Anna Ganun, 93, of Adrian, died Thursday, March 14, 2013, at Grand Court.

She was born February 12, 1920, in Adrian to Karl and Tillie (Bangerter) Roekle. She graduated in 1937 from Adrian High School and earned her B.A. and M.A. degrees from Eastern Michigan University. She married Robert Ganun on July 10, 1942. He preceded her in death on December 1, 1994. She was a teacher in Lenawee County for 35 years, serving 30 years in the Adrian School District, retiring in 1982 from Alexander School. She was a retired member of the MEA, NEA, and MARSP. She was a lifetime member of St. Stephen Lutheran Church in Adrian.

She is survived by three daughters and their husbands, Barbara and Junior Nieman of Adrian; Brenda and Carl Demlow of Coldwater, and Diane and Keith Hudson of Munith. She is also survived by six grandchildren and 17 great grandchildren.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by her brother Arthur Roekle.

Funeral services will be held at St. Stephen Lutheran Church on Monday, March 18, 2013 at 11 a.m. with Pastor Brian Keller officiating. Burial will follow at Palmyra Cemetery. Visitation will be at Wagley Funeral Home, Adrian on Sunday from 2 to 6 p.m.
