



## Orvetta Ann Bristoll

December 7, 1931 - May 22, 2024

ADRIAN- Orvetta Ann Bristoll, age 92, of Adrian, MI died at home on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, with her family by her side and under the care of Hospice of Lenawee.

Orvetta was born at home in Adrian, Michigan, on December 7, 1931, the sixth of James M. and Lois F. (VanSchoik) Bristoll's seven children.

Orvetta graduated from Adrian High School on June 9, 1949. She valued the friendships she made and spent many years working on class reunions, luncheons, and newsletter updates; which helped her classmates keep in touch.
