ADRIAN – Patricia “Pat” Coral Owens, age 81, of Adrian died Thursday, July 1, 2021, at ProMedica, Toledo Hospital with her family by her side. She was born October 5, 1939, in Adrian, to Oren and Opal (Homan) Jones. Pat graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1957.

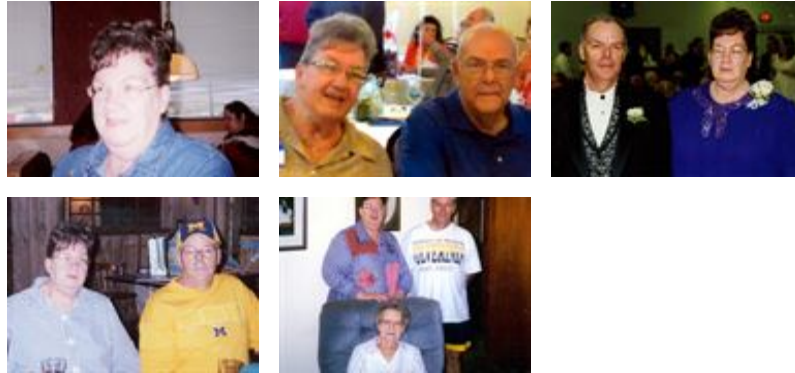
