MANITOU BEACH – Patricia M. Peters, 61, of Manitou Beach passed away, September 3, 2009 at home surrounded by her family.

She was born May 13, 1948 in Owosso, Michigan, the daughter of Anton and Mary Ellen (Jones) Danek. Pat earned her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Spanish from Central Michigan University and a Masters Degree in secondary curriculum from Eastern Michigan University.

On June 25, 1966, Patricia married Jan Peters in Chesaning, Michigan.

Pat taught Spanish at Adrian High School for 31 years, retiring in 2004. Most precious to Pat was time with her family and summer vacations at Higgins Lake. She was an avid reader, a Detroit Tiger fan, an Adrian Maple Fan, and enjoyed golf. She shared her passion for foreign studies with many students traveling to Europe throughout the years. Pat was a member of First United Methodist Church of Adrian.

In addition to Jan, her husband of 43 years, Pat is survived by her daughter, Pamela Peters, and her husband, Michael Hughes, of Chicago; two grandsons, Nicholas and Noah Hughes; her parents, Anton and Mary Ellen Danek, of Owosso; sister, Janis (Tim) Mead of Owosso; sister-in-law, Diane Danek of Canton, MI; and beloved nephews and nieces.

She was preceded in death by a brother, Thomas Danek, in 2008.
