ADRIAN- Patricia Ann Reno, age 89 of Adrian, passed away on Saturday, February 14, 2026, at Brookdale Senior Living. 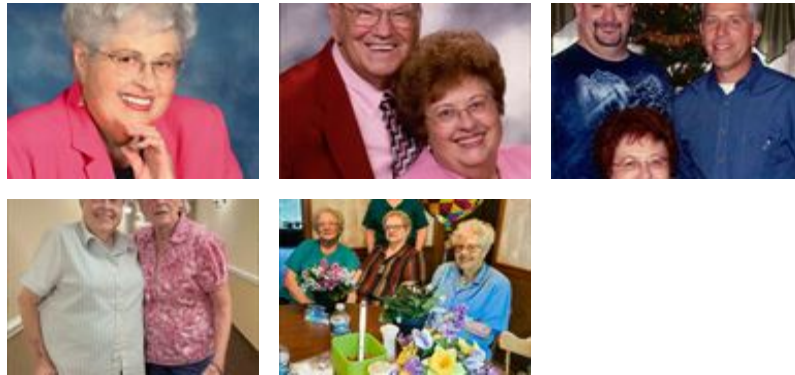
