ADRIAN – Patrick “Pappy” LaHart, Sr., age 76 of Adrian, passed away Sunday, March 22, 2009 at Bixby Medical Center surrounded by his family.

Patrick was born on St. Patrick’s Day, March 17, 1933, in Adrian, the oldest child of Haskell LaHart and Eva May (Huyck) Scott.

During the Korean Conflict he served his country in the Air Force in Newfoundland, Canada where he met and married Joan Mayne. She preceded him in death in 1987. On September 1, 1989, Pat married Sandra (Murray) Staup in Adrian. She survives.

Pat worked for GM for over 30 years at the Hydromatic plant in Toledo, where he retired in 1990. He was a member of the Moose, the VFW Annis-Fint Post #1584, the Eagles and the American Legion.
