BLISSFIELD – Paul M. Spresser, age 89 of Blissfield, formerly of Bedford, passed away Tuesday, March 11, 2014, at the Hospice of Lenawee Home. He was born in W. Virginia on September 13, 1924 to Paul Ernst and Mana (Hutchinson) Spresser. Paul was a World War II veteran, having served in the Air Force.

On September 18, 1964, he married Sharon Raymond in Charlotte, MI, and she survives.

After graduating from Ohio State University he went to work for Owens Illinois as a mechanical engineer, retiring with over 30 years of service. He was a member of the Whiteford Wesleyan Church. Paul was also a member of the American Legion and a former member of The Gideons International. He enjoyed vegetable gardening and, in his younger years, square dancing. In addition to Sharon, his wife of almost 50 years, he is survived by their children: , Jeanne Kyle of California; Timothy Spresser of France; Susan Miller of New Mexico; Gwen (Larry) Cruz of Blissfield; and Laura Graves of Solon, OH; eleven grandchildren; and five great grandchildren.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by a son, Greg, and two brothers, Charles and Winfield Spresser.
