ADRIAN- Peter "Pete" Clifford Stewart, age 62, of Adrian, MI died on Monday, February 19, 2024.

Pete was born on July 5, 1961 in Adrian, MI, the third of Landis C. and Carol (Landis) Stewart's seven children. Pete attended Adrian Public Schools where he was on the high school swim team, a member of the physics club and a straight A student. Pete graduated from AHS in 1979 and went on to Albion College where he earned his Bachelor of Art degree in theatre.

Pete started performing at the Croswell Opera House when he was 6 yrs. old and was part of the Wizard of Oz production. The acting bug stayed with him his whole life and for over 50 years Pete entertained audiences with his singing and acting on stage. Besides performing on stage, Pete had a voice that made him a natural for radio broadcasting. For over 25 years, Pete was involved with the local radio stations: WLEN, WABJ and WQTE where he filled many roles. Pete was a loyal Detroit Tigers fan, loved to water ski and enjoyed looking at classic cars. Pete's easy-going personality and sense of humor will be missed by many in Lenawee County.

He is survived by his siblings, Elizabeth Lucille Stewart, David Landis (Kimberly) Stewart, Joseph Donald (Patricia Maria) Stewart, Frances Marian Stewart, Virginia Landis (Alex Britton) Stewart and Robert Landis (Michelle) Stewart; many wonderful nieces and nephews; and his good friend, Eric Fellman. Pete was preceded in death by his parents.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, March 2, 2024 at noon at Wagley

Funeral Home, Adrian with Rev Larry Betz officiating. There will be a memorial visitation from 11:00 a.m. until the service begins at the funeral home. Burial will be private.

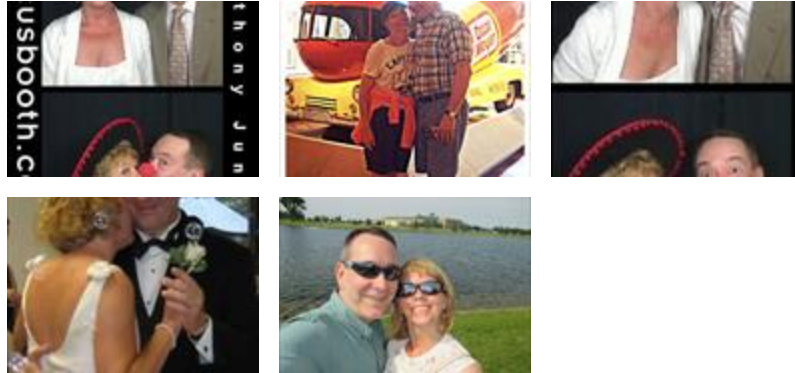
