BLISSFIELD – Raymond Garcia, Jr., 82, died peacefully Monday morning, November 23, 2020 at the Hospice Home of Lenawee surrounded by his family.

Born November 18, 1938 in Dallas, Texas he was the son of the late Raymond and Eva (Garibay) Garcia, Sr. Raymond retired from Nutrien AG Solutions in Blissfield, where he was employed for many years.
