



## Rebecca "Becky" J. Wolfe

September 29, 1950 - May 13, 2013

TOLEDO – Rebecca “Becky” J. Wolfe, 62, of Palmyra, passed away Monday, May 13, 2013, at Toledo Hospital.

She was born September 29, 1950, in Adrian, the youngest child of Wayne and Margaret (Bumpus) Blain. She graduated from Blissfield High School with the Class of 1968 and earned an Associate’s Degree in marketing from Jackson Community College. She completed her education at the Adrian Beauty Academy.

On March 24, 2001, she married Robert Wolfe in Palmyra and he survives. Becky worked as a hair dresser in her home and also for Lenawee Medical Care Facility and Magnumcare. She was a member of the Palmyra Presbyterian Church. She and Robert enjoyed numerous cruises to the Caribbean. They also enjoyed archery together winning the Husband & Wife Trophy in their archery league. Becky was very crafty making yard art and garden totems.
