BLISSFIELD – Richard Lee Calvin, 68, passed away at his home on December 14, 2021, from complications from cancer.

Richard was born on March 24, 1953, to the late Richard Lewis and Elizabeth (Silberhorn) Calvin in Adrian, Michigan. Richard graduated from Adrian High School in 1971 where he had participated in football and wrestling; and worked co-op his senior year in his brother, Jim's, auto body shop.
