



## Richard Neal Gramling Sr.

TECUMSEH- Richard Neal Gramling, Sr., 93, formerly of Tecumseh, MI died on Wednesday evening, August 31, 2022 at Flower Hospital in Sylvania, Ohio with his family by his side.
