BLISSFIELD- Richard E. Jackson, 100, formerly of Palmyra, Michigan died Thursday, June 23, 2022 at Blissfield Place under the care of Hospice of Lenawee.

Born on September 17, 1921 in Detroit, MI, he was the son of Fred E. and Ethlyn (Moore) Jackson. He graduated from Adrian High School.

On March 20, 1943 Richard married Margreet “Muggs” Lucille Coleman and they shared over 68 years together before her passing on November 22, 2011.

Dick accomplished many things and saw great changes during his 100 years of living. He served his country in the United States Army during World War II. Richard worked in welding and maintenance at Stubnitz Green, Harvey Aluminum, Martin Marietta and Jet Wheel Blast of Adrian. He also held the position of postmaster in the Village of Palmyra for several years. Dick was involved with his community serving as the clerk on the Palmyra Township Board for 47 years and was a former member of the Palmyra Fire Department when he was younger.

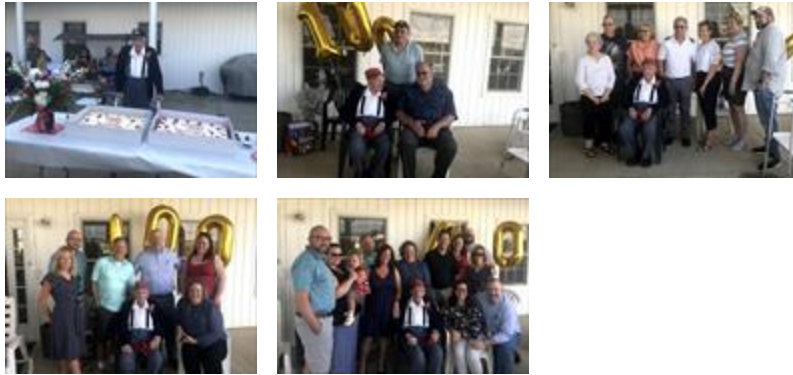
