ADRIAN – Richard P. Yenor, age 92 of Adrian, passed away January 17, 2016, at his home.

Richard was born at home in Adrian Township, June 16, 1926, to LaVerne and Lora (Grattan) Yenor.

He was a 1940 graduate of Adrian High School and during World War II, Richard proudly served in the Army.

On August 29, 1954, Richard married Bessie Kruse in Adrian, and she preceded him in death in 1970.

The majority of his life Richard worked as a chef. He owned Adrian Plaza Restaurant and later worked as a chef for the Dominican Mother House where he retired. He was a member of the Maple City Kiwanis, serving as a Past Lt. Governor for the State of Michigan. Richard was also a member of the First United Methodist Church where he was involved in the Stephen Ministry. As a liaison for the Lenawee County Sheriff's Department, Richard helped many youth in the area.

He is survived by his children: Jan Henley of Adrian, Jon (Caroline) Yenor of Connecticut, and David (Marie) Yenor of Pinckney; grandchildren: Kendra, Janelle (Niko), Nathan, Katie, Evan, Reid and Scott; and great grandchildren: Trinity, Aja, Brendyn and Kaelynn.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by his siblings: Violet Wirick, Mack Yenor and Clare Yenor.
