Blissfield: Robert D. Frautschi, 85, of Blissfield passed away suddenly on Friday, November 12, 2010 at his home.

Bob was born in Toledo, OH on January 7, 1925 to parents Arthur and Eulalee (Hitchcock) Frautschi. He began his education at Liberty Corners, and later graduated from DeVilbiss High School in Toledo, Ohio.

Bob began farming at an early age on his grandfather's farm, where he raised dairy cattle with his father. On September 4, 1947 he married Caroline Whitman at the Temperance Baptist Church in Temperance. In 1950, he and his father opened the Oakleaf Dairy at the corner of Sterns Rd. and Lewis Ave. in Bedford Township. They operated the dairy farm for 10 years at that location, before Bob moved his family to Ogden in 1960 where he continued dairying until 1975. At that time, Bob turned to grain farming with his son until the present.

For the past 21 years, Bob and Caroline have been members at Fairfield Baptist Church, where Bob faithfully served as a deacon and Sunday school teacher. Bob was a spiritual giant and example to all of his family.

Bob is survived by his loving wife Caroline, with whom he shared 63 wonderful years; children, David (Sally) Frautschi and Robin (Rick) Hibdon, both of Blissfield; grandchildren Andrew and Samuel Frautschi, Hannah and Micah Hibdon; a sister, Thelma (Jack) Dusseau of Las Vegas, Nevada and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and 1 sister, Marie Clark.

Funeral services for Bob will be held on Tuesday, November 16, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. at the Wagley Funeral Home, Tagsold Chapel in Blissfield with the Rev. Stephen Boley officiating. Burial will follow in Ogden Zion Cemetery in Ogden. Visiting hours will be held on Monday from 2-4 and 6-8 p.m. at the funeral home.
