ADRIAN - Robert "Bob" McMordie, 90, of Adrian, Michigan, passed away peacefully Saturday morning, March 18, 2023, at Promedica Charles & Virginia Hickman Hospital.

Born on June 17, 1932, in Adrian, MI, he was the son of William and Edna (Schleicher) McMordie. Bob graduated from Adrian High School with the class of 1949, and went on to serve his country in the United States Army from 1955 to 1957.

On December 21, 1968, Bob married Connie Stahl in Toledo, Ohio, and she survives.

Bob owned and operated Bob's West Valley Service, an excavating company, for over 50 years. He was a member of Grace Point Evangelical Free Church, and he loved the Lord. Bob's easy-going personality and ability to socialize with everyone earned him the title of "Mayor of Birdsall" to his friends. One of his favorite past times was the daily coffee with his buddies, where they worked on solving the world's problems. He also liked going to auctions, and you could often find him tinkering in his barn. Most of all, he enjoyed the time spent with his family.

Bobby (Amy) McMordie, and Jason (Lindsey) McMordie; 4 grandchildren, 3 great-grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews. Bob was preceded in death by his parents, his brother Jack, and sister Edna.
