ADRIAN – Robert L. Stevens “Capt.”, 66, of Adrian, passed away Thursday, March 24, 2011, at his home, surrounded by the family he loved.

Robert was born December 24, 1944, in Adrian, the son of Harold and Madeline (Mattice) Stevens. He proudly served in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam War.

On December 17, 1966, Robert married Jane Parker in Adrian. Jane, his wife of over 44 years, survives.

Bob worked for American Chain and Cable. He then went to work for the Department of Corrections, retiring from Gus Harrison Parr Highway Correctional Facility in 2006 with 25 years of service.

Bob was a member of Hope Lutheran Church. He was also a member of the VFW Annis Fint Post #1584, AMVETS Post #1957, American Legion Post 275, and DAV Chapter 20. He enjoyed bowling in leagues. Mostly he treasured time spent with his family at their cabin up north.

In addition to his wife, Bob is survived by his mother, Madeline (Denzel) Smith of Thonotosassa, FL; five children: Wanda Stevens of Adrian; Kelley (Jim) Hargrave of Spring Lake; Amy Teske of Adrian; Elizabeth Stevens of

Kalamazoo; and Daniel (Bettina) Stevens of Adrian; 11 grandchildren: Amanda, Michael, Arron, Pete, Ashley, Alaina, Jennifer, Justin, Jacob, Rachel, and Cambria; six great grandchildren; and his siblings: Thomas (Pamala) Stevens of Adrian; Michael (Nancy) Stevens of Coldwater; and Patricia (Gary) Allshouse of Willis, TX.

He was preceded in death by his father, Harold Stevens.
