TECUMSEH- Rodd Elliot Roesch, 55, of Tecumseh, Michigan, passed away on July 31, 2025, at the Hospice of Lenawee Home in Adrian, Michigan. A beloved husband, father, son, and brother, Rodd lived a full and vibrant life dedicated to family, community, and curiosity.

Rodd was born on July 8, 1970, in Adrian, MI, the youngest son of Edward and Candy (Spiegel) Roesch. He graduated from Adrian High School in 1988 and from Adrian College in December 1992. Rodd began his professional journey as a DJ for WABJ, later serving as a sales representative for both WABJ and Q95 Country. Over the years, his talents and work ethic led him to roles with Kapnick Insurance, Roesch Manufacturing, Sears, and Lowe's. No matter the job, Rodd brought enthusiasm, integrity, and a deep sense of connection to those around him.

father, G. Edward Roesch, and his mother-in-law, Carla VanSickle. He will be remembered for his warmth, curiosity, generous heart, and the joy he brought to every room he entered.
