ADRIAN – Ronald Stanley Brazee, Sr., age 84 of Adrian, passed away Wednesday, November 9, 2016 at Magnumcare in Adrian.

He was born October 25, 1932, in Adrian to Royce and Julia (Newberry) Brazee.

After graduating from Morenci High School in 1950, he went on to study in the field of criminal justice and security.

On August 22, 1998, he married LouAnn Bluntschly on Mackinaw Island, and they have been blessed with 18 years together.

Ronald owned his own his security business and was once the head of the security department at Bixby Hospital. He also organized his own search and rescue team. He was an active member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church and was a member of their dart ball team. Ronald was a former member of Civitan and a lifetime member of the Adrian Moose Club and the Adrian Eagles. He enjoyed traveling with his wife and friends throughout the years and made many more friends during their travels. Ronald treasured spending time with his family.

In addition to his wife, LouAnn, he is survived by his three sons, Ronald Brazee, Jr. of Jackson, Kevin (Teresa) Brazee of Sand Creek, and Tim (Beth) Brazee of Pataskala, OH; his daughter, Julie (Mark) Cooper of Ypsilanti; three step-children, Jeff (Beth) Rohrback of Danville, KY, Brad Rohrback of Muskegon, and Jennifer (David) Helmer of Saline; several grandchildren and great-grandchildren; 3 nephews and 2 nieces.

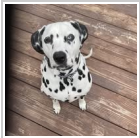
I wanted to add uncle Sonny and LouAnn would meet us and other
