He was born on April 13, 1948, in Long Beach, California, the son of Jesse Harding and Mildred Irene (Berry) Birdsall. He was baptized and is a believer in Jesus Christ.

Ron graduated in 1967 from Union High School, in Union, Missouri. He joined the United States Air Force in 1969 and served for four years during the Vietnam War. Ron was deployed to South Korea as a member of the Tactical Air Support Party in support of the First Rock Army.

On July 15, 1972, Ron married Donna Ward in Independence, MO. During their 52 years together Ron and Donna had many adventures while raising their three children. They started out taking the kids tent camping and this family activity continued for over 40 years. The grandchildren were lucky enough to get in on this family tradition. After Ron and Donna retired, they decided to try something new, and thus began their new adventure- cruising. They took several cruises over the years and made many memories beyond the campsite.

After his time in the service, Ron went on to attend Siena Heights College/University where he received a bachelor's degree in both Computer and Information Systems and Drafting Occupations. Ron worked as an Information Systems Manager for 40 years and retired from Associated Spring

Raymond in 2013.

Ron's hobbies included woodworking, and he was also a member of the Woodworking Warriors Veterans Organization in Lenawee County. Ron would often create handcrafted treasures and share them with family and friends. He also belonged to the Southeast Michigan/Northwest Ohio Woodturners Club. He enjoyed traveling to Ludington, MI, where he would fish for King Salmon with his veteran buddies.
