ADRIAN- Ruby Rupert, 99, of Adrian, Michigan died early Sunday morning, November 19, 2023 at Gaslight Village Assisted Living under the care of Hospice of Lenawee.

She was born on March 4, 1924 in Jane, Missouri, the daughter of Harrison and Opal Carnes. Ruby graduated from White Rock High School with the Class of 1942. From there, Ruby moved to Wichita, KS and worked as a “Rosie the Riveter” working on airplanes. Her next stop was Washington, D.C. where she worked for the United States Navy Department. It was during this time that she met Stanley Rupert, and they were united in marriage on Christmas Eve, December 24, 1945. They were blessed with over 53 years together before Stanley’s passing in 1999.

Ruby and Stanley raised five children and filled their home with much love and laughter while creating many wonderful memories. Ruby enjoyed quilting, sewing and hosting family events. No one could make southern fried chicken the way Ruby did, it was one of her specialties.
