ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. - Rudolph M. "Mitch" Sexton, 91, passed away peacefully in St. Augustine, Fla., on Sunday, Feb. 1, 2015, surrounded by loved ones.

Rudolph was born Nov. 3, 1923, in Hueysville, Ky., son of the late George and Daisy (Allen) Sexton. 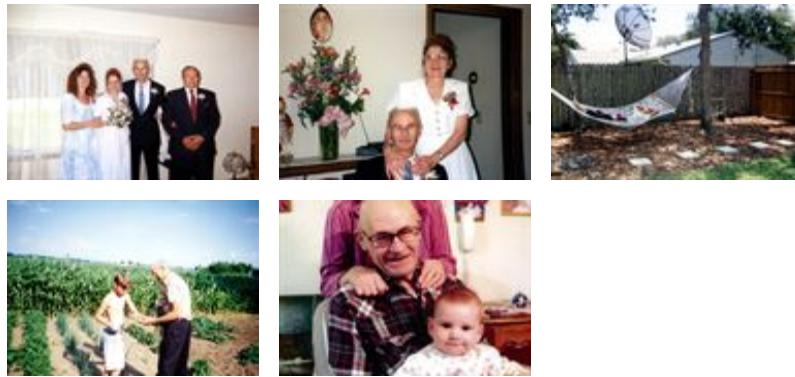
