ONSTED- Ruth E. Bennett, 90, of Onsted, Michigan died Friday evening, August 4, 2023 at Promedica Charles and Virginia Hickman Hospital.

Ruth was born on March 21, 1933 in Jasper, MI, the daughter of Rawlen and Jessie (Saul) Jones. She attended Sand Creek Community Schools and graduated with the Class of 1950. Ruth graduated from Cleary College in 1951. She used her training and skills as a stenographer for the Lenawee County Juvenile and Probate Courts for 10 years before becoming a homemaker.
