ADRIAN – Ruth M. Myers, 91, of Adrian, passed away Tuesday, October 2, 2012, at Lynwood Manor with her family at her side.

Born June 27, 1921, in Wright Township, Michigan, she was the only daughter of Walter and Millie (Havens) Sprague.

On September 18, 1948, Ruth married Darrell E. Myers in Adrian. They celebrated their 50th Anniversary prior to his death in 1998.

Ruth worked at American Chain and Cable and also at Trenton Hills United Brethren Church, now known as The Elem3nt Church, where she was a faithful member. Ruth was happiest when she played piano for others at the senior center, several churches, many nursing homes in the community, and most of all her family.
