ADRIAN – Ruth E. Reinhart, age 91 of Adrian, passed away Tuesday, February 24, 2009 at Bixby Medical Center.

Ruth was born on May 6, 1917, in North Adams, Michigan, the only child of Arthur and Leta (Smith) Randall. She graduated from Adrian High School with the Class of 1935. Ruth attended Adrian College as well as Cleary College where she received her Associate's Degree.

On May 19, 1940, Ruth married Howard Reinhart in Adrian. Howard, her husband of over 68 years, survives.

Ruth worked as a secretary for the First United Methodist Church in Adrian for many years. Prior to that she worked for Lenawee County Abstract. In 1982, Ruth retired from the District Court where she had served as Magistrate.

Ruth was a life-long member of the First United Methodist Church. She was active in the church sewing circle and also a member of a Literary Club. For many years Ruth and Howard spent their winters in Florida. They also enjoyed traveling with friends and camping in their Airstream.

In addition to her husband, Ruth is survived by two sons, Jim Reinhart and John Reinhart and his wife, Sheila, both of Adrian; and three grandchildren,

Kevin, Jason and Kerri.
