ADRIAN- Sally Ann (Mitchell) Underwood, age 80, of Adrian, Michigan died Monday evening, April 8, 2024, at Promedica Charles & Virginia Hickman Hospital.

Sally was born on October 13, 1943, in Adrian, Michigan, the daughter of Murray J. and Fern O. (Summers) Mitchell.
