



Scott Lee Langmeyer

September 1, 1964 - November 9, 2022

DEERFIELD- Scott Lee Langmeyer, 58, passed away in the home he built surrounded by family and joined Jesus in Heaven on November 9th, 2022, after a courageous three year battle with metastatic melanoma.

Scott was born September 1st, 1964, in Adrian, Michigan, and was a lifelong Deerfield resident. He was a talented carpenter for 40 years; he had a passion for finish work and was well-known for his craftsmanship, vision, and work ethic in all he did.

He was a devoted family man, a loving husband, father, son, brother, and uncle. Scott dedicated his life to his 'girls'—Jessie and Jolie—whom he was incredibly proud of and loved with his whole heart. He coached them in softball and enjoyed attending Jessie's cross country meets and Jolie's basketball games. He was incredibly proud of them and supported them throughout their lives. Scott also selflessly served his mom, siblings, and nieces and nephews throughout his life. He was also a member of the Victim Services Unit for the Lenawee County Sheriff's Department, and deeply cared for his community.

Scott loved the Lord and was a true servant. He served as an elder at Ogden Church for 3 years and was influential in his calling. He was very involved with Ogden Student Ministries for 6 years and felt privileged to work with the students each week. He also supported his wife and daughters in their mission trips to Haiti, helping transport and pack each time. Scott, and his wife Bonnie of 33 years, were also very involved with Retrouvaille, a peer ministry

for troubled marriages, since 2002. They learned to keep the Lord at the center of their relationship and to daily decide to love each other. It was their passion, purpose, and joy of Lord to share their story with over 400 hurting couples through the years.

Scott loved to travel up north with his family. He'd roll the windows down as he crossed the Mackinaw Bridge into the UP, his 'Heaven on earth.'

Scott was the strongest man we knew. He had an incredible sense of humor, layered over a strong wisdom. His wife and girls are so blessed to have had him as the leader and provider for their family. His favorite scripture was Joshua 24:15, "And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the Lord, choose this day whom you will serve...But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

Scott is survived by his beloved wife, Bonnie; his daughters Jessie Langmeyer, and Jolie (Tim) Gritmaker; dog Gus and granddog Buck, mother Norma Langmeyer, sister Pam Diver, brother Mike (Laurel) Langmeyer, along with nieces and nephews whom he loved as his own children. He was preceded in death by his father, Elmer Langmeyer; baby sister, Penny Langmeyer; and niece, Haley Langmeyer.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, November 14, 2022, at 11 a.m. at Ogden Church with Pastor Brandon Rickard officiating. Memorial visitation will take place on Sunday, November 13, 2022, from 3 to 7 p.m. at Ogden Church and again on Monday, one hour prior to the start of the memorial service.
