TIPTON- Scott Arthur Turner age 63, of Tipton, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, November 23, 2021 at Henry Ford Allegiance Hospital in Jackson.

Scott was born on March 25, 1958, to Ralph and Rosemarie (Duff) Turner in Detroit, MI. He attended school in the Detroit area until the age of 12 when his parents decided to move the family out to Tipton, MI. The move to country living was a great adventure for Scott and his five siblings. There was always something to do on the farm whether it was feeding the animals or driving the tractor in the fields. Scott graduated from Tecumseh High School with the Class of 1976. Scott served his country in the United States Air Force from 1977-1979.

On November 6, 1976, Scott married the love of his life, Crystal Lynn Harmon, in Tipton and they celebrated their 45th anniversary earlier this month. Scott and Crystal had two boys and were involved in their activities while growing up. Scott helped coach his sons' soccer teams when they were young.

Scott worked the majority of his life in the automotive field. He started out working as a clay model builder/maker and advanced to engineering. He worked at North American Lighting Company for 26 years and retired as a Senior Engineering Manager. Scott always took the time to listen to his staff

and would find ways to improve the work environment. Scott's easy-going personality and kindness was evident in everything he did. Scott was a member of Faith Baptist Church in Adrian for many years and was involved in many ways; he was on the worship team, worked the soundboard, taught Sunday School and was a past Church Deacon. You could always count on Scott to be wearing his Detroit Lions attire and cheering on his team no matter how the season was going, with his sons by his side. Scott was also an avid hunter and looked forward to fall and the challenges it would bring.

In addition to his wife, Crystal, Scott is survived by his sons, Craig (Erica) Turner of Clayton, MI and Jesse (Cassie) Turner of Ypsilanti, MI; grandchildren, Sabrina Turner, Hollie Rule, Jessica Prajzner, Sebastian Turner, Kingston Turner and Kiara Turner; great-granddaughter, Elaine Bates; siblings, Ralph (Susan) Turner, Cynthia (Allan) Andrews, Rodney (Susan) Turner, Virginia (Mike) Harris and Anthony Turner and multiple other extended family members. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral services for Scott will take place on Saturday, December 4, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. at Faith Baptist Church in Adrian. Burial will follow at Lenawee Hills Memorial Gardens in Tecumseh.
