She loved numbers and worked for the state of Michigan, in a variety of positions that included bookwork and balancing budgets for 30 years until she retired in 2012. She continued to serve the community by volunteering with The Salvation Army and The Department of Aging. She always found a way to give to those in need and never said “no” when asked to help.

She had a passion for crocheting and made her children and grandchildren many gifts including blankets that will warm their hearts forever. She loved her family unconditionally until the moment she met Jesus face to face and now she looks upon us all from the right hand of God smiling saying “all is well with my soul”.

Funeral services will take place at 11 a.m., Wednesday, July 22, 2020, at Wagley Funeral Home with Pastor Olivia Nickelson officiating. Burial will be private. Visitation will be held at the funeral home Tuesday from 2 to 8 p.m. Following the Governor’s executive order, all attendees are required to wear a proper face covering, with the exception of those under the age of five years old or those who cannot medically tolerate.
