



## Shirley Ann (Robison) McLemore-Hutt

November 26, 1939 - October 26, 2024

ADRIAN- Shirley Ann (Robison) McLemore-Hutt, 84, of Adrian, passed away peacefully at home on Saturday, October 26th, 2024.

She was born November 26, 1939, in Pulaski, Tennessee to the late Herbert and Ruby (Vernon) Robison. She grew up on a working farm and often told stories of milking cows before school and picking cotton with her six siblings. She had a beautiful childhood with loving and caring parents and spoke highly of that cherished time in her life. No doubt her generosity, helpful spirit and kind heart were nurtured during that time.

Shirley's list of achievements is long and varied. Her talents and personality have always made her memorable, even in high school. She was active in theatre, won an award for a speaking contest (on the topic "I Believe in Democracy") and also dazzled the judges at the Giles County Fair in 1956 by singing the song "I Believe." Her passion and spirit were evident as an accomplished ballroom dancer and instructor for Arthur Murray, and her rhythm was always admired as she clogged, square danced, and even – believe it or not – belly danced in the 70's. Her civic duties included holding the office of President of the P.T.A. at Michener Elementary School (she spear-headed one of the most successful "Fun Night" fundraisers ever held). She was also President of the Ladies Elks Club and consistently created memorable events that were talked about long after they were over. Quite the

athlete, she played basketball and softball in her youth, and later enjoyed bowling on several leagues at Lenawee Recreation and Ten Pin Alley – gaining bragging rights of being one of the few who has bowled a perfect “300” game. What made her happy in her later life was GOLF. (And yep, she shot a hole-in-one once, too). We are not sure which she enjoyed more - playing a round with friends or shopping for new outfits to wear on the course, but she was always dressed to the nines and her family loved that about her. Her professional career included managing the office of the successful company, Adrian Decorators, which she founded with her first husband. She did this while raising 6 children, fiercely protecting them and being their biggest cheerleader. Her kids will tell you; their friends always wanted a “Mom just like her.”

In 1993 she found love again with Richard “Dick” Hutt. Together they traveled extensively, while also enjoying their log cabin in northern Michigan and a condo in Venice, Florida in the winters. You would often find them together at the American Legion raising their glasses with friends and saying, “Skoal!” Dick loved her and cared for her so beautifully. She missed him immensely after his unexpected death in 2022. They were, no doubt, soul mates. We know he welcomed her home to heaven.

Shirley loved ice cream, golf, shopping, crossword puzzles, smiley faces, flowers and having fun. She adored Halloween, flying kites, Dr. Phil, afternoon naps and the word “Shit!” While we always marveled at her ability to hold a grudge, she would be the first person to jump and help whenever a friend or family member was in need. She was known for her warm heart, infectious smile and laugh, her sense of humor, and her famous banana pudding – which often caused playful scuffles at family gatherings. A true warrior and firecracker, she will be remembered for her fighting spirit, her courageousness, and her insatiable ability to focus on the positive. She, above all, loved her children and counted them as her greatest

accomplishment in her life.

Left to cherish her memory are her six children, Mike (Michelle) McLemore, Melinda McLemore (Dennis Swiggum), Marty (Tammie) McLemore, Matt (Valerie) McLemore, Beebe (Mike) Reno and Kathy McLemore Maguire; her grandchildren, TJ, Alisa, Chad, Jennifer, Megan, Adam, Laura, Ben and Luke; 22 great-grandchildren; brother, Ric Robison; sister, Sandra Davis and a tribe of beautiful friends that she loved and appreciated. She was preceded in death by her husband of 27 years, Dick Hutt; her grandson, Shaun McLemore; her first husband, Dolton McLemore (who was the father of her children), her parents, 3 brothers, 1 sister, and many precious friends.

The family will receive visitors beginning at 3 p.m. on Friday, November 1st, 2024 at Wagley Funeral Home in Adrian. Memorial services will begin at 4 p.m. with Pastor Bruce Jewett officiating. Cremation has taken place, and interment will be held privately at a later date.
