Stanley J. Dusseau, 81, of Deerfield, passed away Saturday, June 16, 2012, at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor.

Born September 11, 1930, in Dundee, Michigan, Stanley was the youngest child of Cletus and Anna (Cousino) Dusseau.

He was stationed in Germany while serving his country in the United States Army.

On September 25, 1954, Stanley married Mildred Kucera at the Holy Rosary Church in Toledo, Ohio. Millie, his wife of over 57 years, survives.
