JEROME- Stuart Alan Steller, 68, of Jerome, Michigan died late Friday evening, April 14, 2023 at home under the care of Elara Hospice and surrounded by his family.

Born on November 26, 1954 in Lynn, Massachusetts, he was the oldest child of Milton and Betty (Schwartz) Steller. Stuart's Jewish upbringing was important to him as he attended Hebrew School at Ahabat Shalom and treasured his given Hebrew name, Shlomo. Stuart graduated from Lynn English High School in 1972 and went on to attend the University of Miami in Florida and Williams University in Rhode Island.

Stuart had many talents and interests during his lifetime. As a young man he enjoyed outdoor activities from surfing and diving to downhill snow skiing. Years later he really enjoyed a good game of volleyball, especially if the game was on a tropical beach during a vacation. Most recently you could find Stuart relaxing at home on North Lake LeAnn driving his pontoon boat. Early years as an auto mechanic led to years of joy working on his own automobiles. Stuart had a real estate license and was always looking for investment opportunities. He loved all kinds of music, which led to a dual career as a DJ for 25 years, including some radio; but he had a real passion for working weddings and events. After 25 successful years in sales with Advanstar, Stuart retired in 2021 for the final time and moved to Michigan full time. If you knew Stuart, you knew he was not an impulse buyer. He would research whatever he was interested in, no matter how big or small, and then do more

research before making the purchase. This trait earned him a great deal of teasing from his family and friends. Stuart's personality naturally drew people to him when he entered a room. He was described by others as a genuine person and an intentional friend.

Stuart and Marlene started dating in the Spring of 2001, and on January 7, 2023 he married the love of his life Marlene Westgate-Lemley. For over 21 years, the two of them have shared much laughter, created many memories, traveled and built a family together. Stuart and Marlene attended Abundant Life Assembly of God in Cement City. They have been raising their grandchildren, Jackson and Skylar, who affectionately called Stuart "GuyGuy". In addition to his wife, Marlene, Stuart is survived by his father, Milton; daughter, Corrine Steller; Marlene's daughter, Christina Lemley; grandchildren, Jackson and Skylar Wright; siblings, Sheryl Steller (Bobby Bird) and Brian Steller (Cheryl Zuppa); niece, Kate (Dylan) Beaulieu and nephew, Will Steller; cousins; and many wonderful friends. Stuart was preceded in death by his mother, Betty, daughter, Stephanie Sharp and granddaughter, Morgan Sharp.

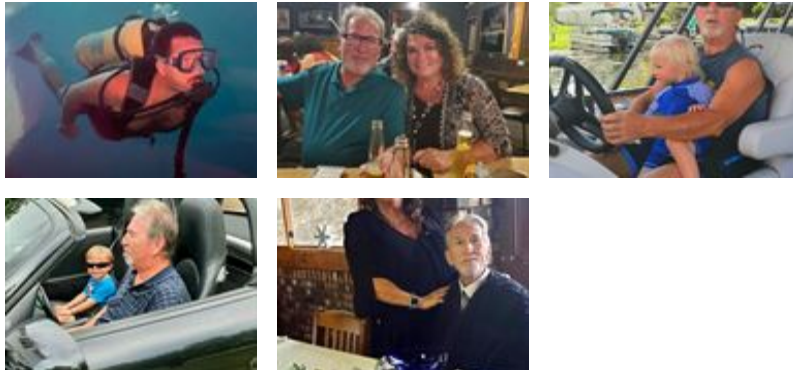
