



## Susan "Sue" Maxine Liedel

May 1, 1946 - October 6, 2021

BLISSFIELD—Susan “Sue” Maxine Liedel age 75, of Blissfield, died at West Park Place in Toledo, OH on Wednesday, October 6, 2021 with her family by her side.

She was born on May 1, 1946 to William M. and Bernice (VanDoren) Fry in Adrian. Susan grew up in Adrian, where her family owned the Sleepy Hollow Motel. Sue was kept busy cleaning the rooms at the motel, earning 25 cents for each room she cleaned. She graduated from Madison High School and went on to attend Toledo University.

On May 7, 1966 Susan married Todd Ernest Liedel at West Adrian Congregational Church and they have shared 55 wonderful years together.

Sue was a talented “crafter” making quilts, sewing and creating jewelry that she shared with her family and friends. She enjoyed gardening but her flowers usually had a short lifespan and seldom made it through the summer. Sue was a master at shopping, and “bonded” with her daughter and granddaughter on their annual Black Friday Shopping excursions. It was typical to wake up at 3 a.m. and drive a couple of hours to their shopping destination. Susan loved her family and attended all her children and grandchildren’s school and sporting events. One summer she was a devoted fan of travel softball and never missed a game. Sue was fortunate to have her own personal IT support

technician. Grandson Dustin, often made house calls to Grammy and Grampy whenever there was a computer issue. Earlier in life, Susan attended West Adrian Congregational Church; and in more recent years, Susan and Todd attended Zion United Brethren Church in Ogden.

In addition to her husband, Todd, Susan is survived by their children, Todd Marshall Liedel and Dee Dee Liedel; and grandchildren, Dustin Lloyd Miller and August Ann Miller. She was preceded in death by her parents.

Honoring Sue's wishes, cremation will take place. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, October 9, 2021 at 11:00 AM at Wagley Funeral Home, Tagsold Chapel in Blissfield with Rev.
