



## Velma Fay Carpenter

July 11, 1922 - February 11, 2022

ADRIAN – Velma Fay Carpenter, age 99, a life-long resident of the Hudson area, went to be with her Lord, who she loved and served, on February 11, 2022, at Charlotte Stephenson Manor in Adrian.

Velma was born on July 11, 1922, in Hudson, Michigan, the youngest child of Frank and Flossie (Webster) Harden.

On March 28, 1941, Velma married Edwill Carpenter and they were blessed with 70 years together before his passing on July 9, 2011. Family meant everything to Velma, and she treasured her titles of wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and great-great-grandmother.

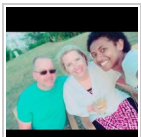
