JASPER—Vernon ‘Vern’ McMunn, 88, of Jasper, passed away, Tuesday, May 3, 2016 at his home, under the loving care of his devoted family.

He was born on May 28, 1927, at home, in Ogden Township, MI, to Vern and Dora (Hite) McMunn. On February 22, 1947, Vern married the love of his life, Fern L. Thompson at St. Paul’s Lutheran Church in Blissfield. They celebrated 69 years of marriage before his death, Fern survives.

After graduating from Metamora High School in 1944, he became a life long farmer, loving every aspect of farming, including planting and harvesting his crops. God was very much a part of Vern and Fern’s everyday life—Vern believed he was God’s helper farming His land. Vern was a faithful member of St. Paul’s Church, where he served on the church board and a former member of the Sand Creek School Board, the Fairfield Township Board and the Farm Bureau.
