ONSTED – Virginia A. Pender, age 86 of Onsted, passed away Saturday, October 21, 2017, at Charlotte Stephenson Manor.

She was born September 1, 1931, in Addison, Michigan, the only child of Harry and Betsy (Wheaton) Green, and graduated from Onsted High School.
