ANN ARBOR – Viva E. Sundquist, age 91, formerly of Adrian, passed away Thursday, June 18, 2009 at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor.

Viva was born August 18, 1917 in Gladwin, MI, the daughter of Herman and Martha (Stienkraus) Nightingale. On October 28, 1972, Viva married Doyle Sundquist. Doyle her husband of over 36 years, survives.

During World War II, Viva worked at Hurd Lock. She was a night supervisor at the Adrian Training School for 17 years, retiring in 1977. Viva was an active member of the Palmyra Presbyterian Church where she served as the Clerk of Session, Chair of Outreach and a member of the Researchers Class. She was also a Past President of the VFW Annis Fint Post #1584 and a member of the Jasper Rebekah Lodge.

In addition to her husband, Viva is survived by four sons: Garth (Judith) Gottschalk of Ann Arbor, Arthur Gottschalk of Adrian; Gary Sundquist of Novi and Kevin (Carma) Sundquist of Saginaw; a brother, Frederick Nightingale of Cadillac; four grandchildren: Erik Sundquist, Andrea (Larry) Donohue, Corey (Rebecca) Sundquist, and Karen Sundquist; and six great grandchildren.

Viva was preceded in death by her first husband, Garth Gottschalk, two brothers and two sisters.

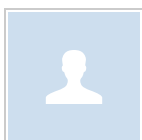
