Wanda Mae Staup, 86, passed away in the early morning of Wednesday, October 05, 2011 at Brown Memorial Convalescent Home in Royston, Georgia. She was born on September 28, 1925 in Adrian, Michigan to Jacob and Cora (Wood) Knierim. On August 24, 1947, Wanda was united in marriage to George A. Staup. Mr. Staup preceded her in death on March 23, 1991.

Wanda graduated from Adrian High School in 1943 and then from the University of Michigan School of Nursing in 1946. She was employed as an R.N. at the Bixby Medical Center for many years before retiring in 1983.

Wanda was a member of the Adrian First United Methodist Church where she served as a former president of the United Methodist Women, a group leader and taught Sunday school for several years, as well as holding various other offices in the church. She was a life member of the U of M School of Nursing Alumni Association, a life member of the D.A.V. Auxiliary Chapter #20 and also a life member of the U of M Alumni Association. Wanda had been at one time affiliated with the American Red Cross assisting with the blood bank and diabetic program. She was awarded a Red Cross pin for her hours of service.

In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents.

Surviving are her daughter, Jill E. (Danny) Bailey of Hartwell, GA, and her son, Neal G. (Kathy) Staup, of Onsted, MI; a brother, Virgil J. (June) Knierim of Jackson, MI; four grandchildren, Aleigha and Aaron Staup, Christopher Swords and Matthew Bailey; and 6 great-grandchildren.

The funeral service for Wanda will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, October 10, 2011, at Wagley Funeral Home with Rev. Chris Brundage and Rev. Greg Burdine officiating. Burial will follow at Palmyra Cemetery.
