ADRIAN – Warren H. Stultz, age 87 of Adrian, passed away Thursday, April 2, 2009 at Lenawee Medical Care Facility.

Warren was born December 24, 1921 in Jackson, Michigan, the oldest child of Charles and Claretta (Hammon) Stultz. During World War II, Warren served his country in the US Army. On June 14, 1952, Warren married Clara Pauline Boroff. They celebrated 55 years of marriage prior to her death in 2008.

Warren worked for Tecumseh Products for many years, retiring in 1987. He was a Boy Scout Leader and former member of the First Baptist Church in Adrian. In his later years, Warren attended Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses in Adrian. Warren brought much joy to senior citizens in Lenawee County when he would sing and play guitar at many of the senior centers.

Warren is survived by his daughter, Shirley Maurer of Adrian; a brother, Charles (Virginia) Stultz of Avondale, AZ; and a sister, Bernice Parker of Phoenix, AZ; two grandchildren, Byron (Kristie) Taulton, II of San Diego and Tamaris Henagan of Columbus, OH; seven great grandchildren and one great great grandchild.

In addition to his wife, Warren was preceded in death by a son, Gary Stultz.

At Warren's request, cremation has taken place. A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, April 13, 2009 at Wagley Funeral Home.
