



## Wilford Tucker

July 17, 1916 - February 16, 2011

ADRIAN – Wilford Ivan Tucker, 94, formerly of Adrian, passed away February 16, 2011 at his home in Charlotte, Michigan.

Wilford was born on July 17, 1916 the fourth child of Harry and Shirley (Bragg) Tucker in Britton Michigan. He attended and graduated from Britton High School. During World War II, Wilford served in the Army in the artillery division.

On September 15, 1945, Wilford married Irene Wade at the West Adrian United Church of Christ where they have been members for many years. Wilford worked as an Inspector for Tecumseh Products for over 30 years. He was also a member of the Maple City Mens Garden Club, a past 4H Leader and served on the Board of Directors for the Tecumseh Credit Union.

Wilford is survived by his wife, Irene, of 65 years, his children, Ned (Jorga) Tucker of Ft. Meyers, Florida, and Suzanne (Ken) Mishler of Dimondale, Michigan, his 7 grandchildren, 5 great grandchildren and one great great grandchild. Also surviving are his siblings, Elwood Tucker, Norma Ries and Imo (Weldon) Russell.

Wilford was preceded in death by his parents, brothers Virgil and Bernard (Pearl) Tucker, and another brother in infancy, his sister Helen (Gene) Flint

and his brother-in-law Harold Ries.
