ADRIAN – William H. “Bill” Dinse, age 86 of Adrian, passed away Sunday, October 9, 2016, at Brookdale Adrian.

He was born August 2, 1930 in Milan, Michigan, the only son of Herman and Minnie (Meyer) Dinse. Bill graduated from Onsted High School with the class of 1947, and completed his education at Jackson Business University.
