ADRIAN – William Frederick Marvin, 94, of Adrian died peacefully at his home on Saturday, February 12, 2022 surrounded by his family while under the compassionate care of Elara Caring Hospice.

Born June 17, 1927 in Adrian, William was the son of John A. and Emma B. (Weisenberger) Marvin. He is survived by his wife, Rosemary A. (Wilson) Marvin, who he married on June 19, 1952 in Adrian. He is also survived by his children, Deborah G. (Daniel) Powers of Canton, MI, Dr. Mark W. (Silvia) Marvin of San Diego, CA, and Timothy J. (Marie) Marvin of Livonia, MI.

William is additionally survived by his five grandchildren, Dr. Danielle (Brad) Powers Herbeck, DPT of Commerce Twp., Kirsten (Chris) Powers Emmert of Farmington Hills, Aaron W. Marvin of San Diego, Joseph Marvin of Kalamazoo, and John-Paul Marvin of Livonia; three great-grandchildren, Finn, Remi, and Dirk Herbeck; sister, Jane Dempsey of Adrian; brother, James (Joy) Marvin of Clayton; and sister-in-law, Bertha Marvin.

Bill retired from Northern Telecom Networks, Ann Arbor Research Center in 1990, as Director of the Computer System Design Department, where he was employed for over 20 years. He traveled as a Communication Specialist throughout the United States and Italy, resolving IBM interface problems. Bill was also employed as a Computer System Designer for Sycor, Inc., where he

was the Communication and I/O Expert and helped to develop the first patented computer systems and Honeywell Computers.

Prior to becoming a Computer Analyst, Bill was engaged in the farming industry. He received an award for Farmer of the Year.

He was a real estate broker for many years. He had been a member of the Lenawee County Association of Realtors, as well as state and national affiliates. He has received many real estate awards. Bill has been involved in many land development projects over the years throughout Lenawee County and Southern Michigan.

In his spare time, Bill enjoyed golf and bowling. He traveled with his wife to Ireland, Italy, Europe, and extensively throughout the United States; often visiting with his son and family in San Diego. Bill and Rosemary enjoyed many Caribbean cruises and spent time each year in Daytona Beach Shores, Florida.

Bill was a lifelong member (since 1948) of the Knights of Columbus Council 1665. He hosted their corn roast for many years. He was also a member of the Ancient Order of the Hibernians, where he held an officer's position for many years. Bill was an active member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and was involved in many activities and committees. He served as Council President during the church's centennial celebration in 1972.

In addition to his parents, William was preceded in death by his sister, Mary Helen Marvin; brother, Jack Marvin; a niece; and three nephews.
