ADRIAN – William “Bill” D. Vogel, age 79 of Adrian, passed away Monday, July 6, 2015, at his home under the loving care of his family and Hospice of Lenawee.

He was born March 14, 1936, on the family farm in Holloway, Michigan, to Floyd and Verda (Spaur) Vogel. Bill graduated with the Class of 1954 from Adrian High School.

On September 2, 1955 he married Myrna Anderson at the Chapel in the Garden in Angola, Indiana, and they have been blessed with almost 60 years together.

Bill worked in several management positions at Brazeway, where he retired in 1995, with 42 years of service. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church for 55 years. Bill loved animals and enjoyed taking evening drives with family to see deer.

He is also survived by his dog, Muffin, who was his constant companion.

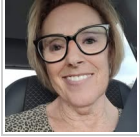
