ADRIAN – Willie G Bragg, 91, of Adrian, passed away Monday, October 4, 2010, at her home under the loving care of her family.

Willie was born October 25, 1918, in Tullahoma, Tennessee, the oldest daughter of Oscar and Georgia (Richardson) Nelson. Willie moved to Michigan in 1942 and met her beloved husband, Elmer C. Bragg, whom she married on January 16, 1944.
