BLISSFIELD – Yvonne S. Diedrich, age 57 of Blissfield, passed away unexpectedly at her home Wednesday, January 29, 2014.

Contributions in memory of Yvonne may be made to the Lenawee Humane Society or your local humane society.

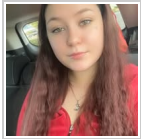
